


Clergy Matters in our Pastoral Area of Central & West Reading

In February Father John Creagh moved from his post as Chaplain to the Royal Berkshire Hospital and has taken up an appointment in Oxfordshire. Bishop Crispian asked Father Chris Whelan to take responsibility for chaplaincy cover at the RBH and he has agreed. However, as you probably know, Chris also serves the community at St John Bosco in Woodley and for this reason Father Richard is now sharing the chaplaincy work with Chris. Between them they provide most of the priestly pastoral cover for the RBH but Richard is now also visiting Prospect and the Duchess of Kent on a regular basis. One of the things that Father Creagh developed in the Hospital was a team of lay people who would visit patients and take Communion to those who wished to receive. All of this will continue because it helps ensure that people who are ill and in hospital are properly provided for.

This means that Father Richard now divides his time between his Hospital responsibilities and working from English Martyrs as part of the clergy team in this Pastoral Area of Central and West Reading. However, it does mean that we will see less of Father Andrew Summersgill at weekends although he will be celebrating Mass at St James on some weekends. I believe that this arrangement, which the Bishop has put in place, will provide greater depth of cover and pastoral care on the part of the priests. I am very aware that, on my own at English Martyrs, there were things that slipped through the gaps and simply weren't being done.

There is more good news! The arrangement for Father Joseph to come and be resident at St Joseph's in Tilehurst was originally for one year and would have expired this summer. However, Joseph's Bishop in the Cameroon has agreed to him staying with us for three more years – until 2011 – and our Bishop's plan is to allow him to remain with us in Reading, based in Tilehurst. Over those next three years he will also be working towards a doctorate with Southampton University but assures me that he will manage that alongside all the pastoral responsibilities he has. I know that you will all be delighted to hear that, not only do we avoid any further changes of priest at St Joseph's, but that Father Joseph is staying with us for the next few years.
