FIRST HOLY COMMUNION PROGRAMME 2017/18

If your child is in Year 3 or above, you are invited to collect an Enrolment Form and a Parental Consent form from the church porch or, for convenience, from St Paul's School Office. The completed forms, together with a copy of your child's Baptismal certificate and payment, should be returned to the Parish Office by **Thursday, 14th September at 12 noon**. Parents, together with their First Holy Communion child, are asked to attend the classes which will be scheduled once a month on a Saturday morning - dates to be confirmed. Parents are also asked to bring their child along on the following Sunday for a First Holy Communion Celebration Mass at 10.30 am.

8 DAY PILGRIMAGE TO ROME & SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO

In Rome, we will visit Basilica of St Mary Major, Basilica of St John Lateran, Trevi Fountain, to name but a few, and of course, the Vatican for a guided tour. In St Giovanni Rotondo, the visits will include the tomb of St Pio, a tour of the sanctuary, view the crucifix where St Pio received the stigmata and the Grotto of St Michael the Archangel. Pilgrimage dates: Monday, 15th October - Monday, 22nd October 2018. The cost will be £991 per person based on minimum of 30 persons. Single room supplement is £240 per person.
