#### MARCH, THE MONTH OF ST JOSEPH

The month of March by custom is devoted to St Joseph - depicted in the statue in the chapel of the Venerable English College, Rome. We look forward to his great feast day on 19<sup>th</sup> March. The Holy Father Pope Francis dedicated 2020/2021 to him in commemoration of the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the saint's proclamation as the Patron of the Universal Church by Pope Pius IX on 8<sup>th</sup> December 1870. We have many reasons to invoke him in our prayers. One traditional prayer that you may or may not be familiar with is the Litany of St Joseph. It was approved for public use by Pope St Pius X in 1909, although its origins go back further.
