APPEAL FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF SPUC READING BRANCH, MARTIN MARTINEZ:

Dear Friends,

Over the past couple of years, the prolife struggle against the culture of death has not been easy; there have been various setbacks, most notably the temporary introduction of home DIY abortion using the Covid pandemic as a pretext, then making it permanent despite the overwhelming negative response to the consultation. And then the imposition of the most draconian abortion laws on Northern Ireland by our UK Government. But not a time to lose heart, not now, not ever! Record numbers of 40 days for life vigils established outside abortion centres have resulted in thousands of babies' lives being saved, abortion workers leaving the business and some even joining the prolife movement. But most encouraging of all was the US Supreme Court judgement overturning Roe V Wade and establishing there was never a constitutional right to abortion with the result that many states have now been able to pass laws banning or restricting access to abortion.

Therefore, we need to take advantage of this new momentum against the Culture of Death by getting involved with various prolife activities: praying outside the abortion clinic, leafleting, joining our local SPUC branch for other campaign activities, attending the march for life event, etc. It will take some effort, sacrificing our valuable time, perhaps suffering insults, verbal abuse, mockery, disapproval. At the end of the day, what will our Lord say to each of us when we appear before him in judgement at the end of our lives? I hope it will be the following words: "Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee hungry, and fed thee? or thirsty, and gave thee drink? 38 When saw we thee a stranger, and took thee in? or naked, and clothed thee? 39 Or when saw we thee sick, or in prison, and came unto thee? 40 And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me." (Matthew 25, v37-40)

1. ANNUAL MARCH FOR LIFE IN LONDON: SATURDAY, 3RD SEPTEMBER

This event starts with an indoor prolife festival with various activities for children of all ages as well as adults then continues with a procession through the streets of London ending in parliament square where a stage will have been set up for keynote speeches, and ending with a time for prayer or remembrance. Depending on numbers, we are planning to organise 1 or more coaches to take us there and back and are currently getting quotes. PRAYER FOR RUSSIA & UKRAINE


Please continue to pray for Peace in Russia and Ukraine:
