

ASH WEDNESDAY

ASH WEDNESDAY will be on 14th February. Mass will be celebrated at 12 noon & 7 pm. Ashes will be blessed and distributed at both Masses. A day of fasting and abstinence which is mandatory on both Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Lent calls us to repent, to a time of prayer, fasting and almsgiving.
