# LETTER TO CATHOLICS IN ENGLAND AND WALES FROM THEIR BISHOPS

The letter for the forthcoming General Election has been issued in the name of the Archbishops of Westminster, Cardiff, Southwark, Birmingham and Liverpool, has the agreement of all the members of the Bishops' Conference. As we approach the General Election on 8th June, it is hoped that this leaflet will be of use to all members of our parish and religious communities as you prepare to cast your vote, offering a framework for your own discernment of the issues at hand.
